NOTICE OF RACE AND SPECIAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 - Rules

These instructions shall be read in conjunction with the PCC General Sailing Instructions. If there is any conflict between these and the General Sailing Instructions then these instructions shall take precedence. Any Notices to competitors (see General Sailing Instruction 8 in the PCC yearbook) will take precedence over both these and the General Sailing Instructions. These Rules are to be read in conjunction with the Vining Marine Single handed Series Rules.

2 - Eligibility

Boats entering this race shall have current registration with YNZ and must display their correct registration numbers on sails in accordance with the Rules of Sailing. This Series is open to all vessels which comply with the clauses of this Notice of race.

All Skippers Must Wear An Approved Lifejacket Whilst Underway. Skippers Must Carry On Their Person The Means To Self-Initiate A Rescue In The Event They Fall Overboard While Underway

One person only permitted on board while racing.

Series Race Entry Fees must have been received by Richmond Yacht Club no later than 1600hrs 6th October 2016. Weekend only entries will be accepted for these 2 races directly through the PCC but this will not allow the competitor eligibility to Series prizes or Benefits but eligible for races 1 and 2.

Weekend only Entry Fees for the 2 races:

Members \$40.00 / Non members \$60 to be paid to the PCC office.

4 - Start times and Divisions:

5 - Courses and Racing Area

The course on the day will be displayed on the start boat by way of a flag. Day 1 start will be between Orakei Yellow buoy and the Patrol Boat. Day 2 start will be between a laid mark and the patrol boat in the area off Gulf Harbour Marina

Course 1 WHITE Fleet

Start Orakei – Orapapa Island (P) – Piripiri Yellow Buoy (S) – Tiri Passage Navy Buoy (outer)(P) finishing East to West between the finish boat and laid mark off the entrance to GHM.

Course 1 YELLOW Fleet

Start Orakei – Orarapa Island (P) – Tiri Passage Navy Buoy (outer)(P) finishing East to West between the finish boat and laid mark off the entrance to GHM.

Course 2 WHITE Fleet

Start Orakei – A Buoy (P) – Torbay Yellow Buoy (S) - Piripiri Yellow Buoy (S) - finishing West to East between the finish boat and laid mark off the entrance to GHM.

Course 2 YELLOW Fleet

Start Orakei - Piripiri Yellow Buoy (S) - finishing West to East between the finish boat and laid mark off the entrance to GHM.

Course 3 WHITE Fleet

Start - Orapapa Island (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

Course 3 YELLOW Fleet

Start - Motuihe Island (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

Course 4 WHITE Fleet

Start – A Buoy (S) – Cable yellow buoy (P) – Illomama Yellow buoy (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

Course 4 YELLOW Fleet

Start – A Buoy (S) – Cable yellow buoy (P) – Flax Point Yellow buoy (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

6 – Finishing

Due to berthing requirement in Fairway Bay the fleet may need to enter as a group at the same time. Please observe instructions from the patrol Boat on finishing with regards to this.

7 - Time Limits

The time limit shall be at the discretion of the Race Officer but no more than 5 hours.

8 - Scoring

As per the Single handed Series scoring system

9 - Prize giving and prizes

For day 1 race to be held at Fairway Bay area (to be advised depending on weather) not prior to 1600hrs. Boats must be present to collect prizes. Race 2 prizegiving to be in the PCC clubrooms at 1600hrs on Sunday the 9th. A BBQ and a few 'lemonades' will be held ashore. A dinghy will be running around picking up and dropping off crews.

10 - Disclaimer

Entrants participate entirely at their own risk as per ISAF Rule 4. **It is entirely up to the individual skipper to decide if they start and/or continue to race.** The Organising Authority/s and/or Sponsors will not accept any liability for the material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the events.

Start Orakei – A Buoy (P) – Torbay Yellow Buoy (S) - Piripiri Yellow Buoy (S) - finishing West to East between the finish boat and laid mark off the entrance to GHM.

Course 2 YELLOW Fleet

Start Orakei - Piripiri Yellow Buoy (S) - finishing West to East between the finish boat and laid mark off the entrance to GHM.

Course 3 WHITE Fleet

Start - Orapapa Island (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

Course 3 YELLOW Fleet

Start - Motuihe Island (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

Course 4 WHITE Fleet

Start – A Buoy (S) – Cable yellow buoy (P) – Illomama Yellow buoy (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.

Course 4 YELLOW Fleet

Start – A Buoy (S) – Cable yellow buoy (P) – Flax Point Yellow buoy (S) - finishing East to West between the patrol boat and Orakei Yellow buoy.
