#### 1.0 RULES

- 1.1 These races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations (YNZ Safety Regs) Part 2 Category 4 shall apply to keelers.

The YNZ Safety Regs Part 5 Category B shall apply to trailer yachts.

- 1.3 The RRS will be changed as follows:
  - RRS Rule 29.2 is changed as per RYC General Sailing Instructions (GSI) 11.5.
  - RRS Rule 44.1 is changed as per GSI 13.2.
  - RRS Rule 51 is modified to allow boats with moveable/variable ballast systems and/or canting keels to compete.
  - RRS Rule 52 'Manual Power' shall not apply.
  - RRS Rule 60.1(a) is changed as per GSI 15.4
  - RRS Rule 62.1(a) is changed as per GSI 11.6.

The changes appear in full in the GSI and may also change other racing rules.

# 2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 These races are open to keelers and trailer vachts.
- 2.2 Eligible boats, including Richmond Sail-Pass holders, may enter the individual races by completing the online registration form on the website richmondyc.org.nz. Entries will be accepted until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 7 December 2022.
- 2.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant shall be a financial member of a club recognised by YNZ.

#### 6.0 VENUE

Races will be held on the Waitemata Harbour and Hauraki Gulf.

# 7.0 COURSES

- 7.1 The Start and Finish are described in the current RYC GSI.
- 7.2 The courses for Races 1 and 3 are described in *Appendix A*: 2022-2023 RYC Harbour Courses ...
- 7.3 The course for Race 2

From the start, round Rangitoto and Motutapu Islands either to port (P) or starboard(S), Torpedo Buoy (P) then to finish.

7.4 In the event of unsuitable weather for Race 2, the Race Officer may opt to shorten the course prior to the race start by choosing one of the harbour courses described in Appendix A 2022-2023 RYC Harbour Courses ...

In this case the tower will fly the 'C' flag and the relevant course number.

# 8.0 SCORING

A boat's series score will be the total of her three race scores, this changes Rule A2.1.

#### 9.0 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded at RYC clubrooms at 1700 hours Sunday, 11 December 2022.
- 9.2 Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd on Handicap.
- 9.3 Handicap prizes will be held at the RYC office for 2 months and will be forfeited if not claimed within this timeframe. It is the skipper's responsibility to check the results and collect prizes.

#### 10.0 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

# 11.0 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the series.
