RYC Gulf Triangle Sailing instructions 18.3 Position reporting (scheds)

The sailing instructions have changed as below

18.3 Position Reporting (Scheds):

<u>Leg</u>	<u>Sched</u>
1	As per R66 SI
2	When passing Sail Rock call Coastguard on Channel 60/64 Before Starting the Race Skippers will log A Trip Report With NZ Coast Guard Via VHF radio channel 05 or 18 or by mobile phone *500 or the CG app. Provide your Radio Call sign, details of destination, POB and ETA. And 30 minutes from the finish call RYC Race Control on Channel 17
3	When passing Little Barrier Island call Coastguard on Channel 60/64 And South of Tiritiri Matangi Island call Coastguard on Channel on 60/64 Before Starting the Race Skippers will log A Trip Report With NZ Coast Guard Via VHF radio channel 60 or 64 [Kawau ch 03] or by mobile phone *500 or the CG app. Provide your Radio Call sign, details of destination. POB and ETA. And 30 minutes from the finish call RYC Race Control on Channel 17
	In addition once finished legs 2 & 3 all competitors are required to clear with Coastguard radio. Once finished legs 2 & 3 all competitors will be required to close their trip report with Coastguard radio [if using the phone app you will need to close the trip report on the app.]

18.4 The Sched/**Trip report** is complete when Race Control/Coastguard acknowledges your Sched/**Trip report**. This is true for both VHF and phone communications.
