41 – 21 Great Barrier Island – no anchoring areas

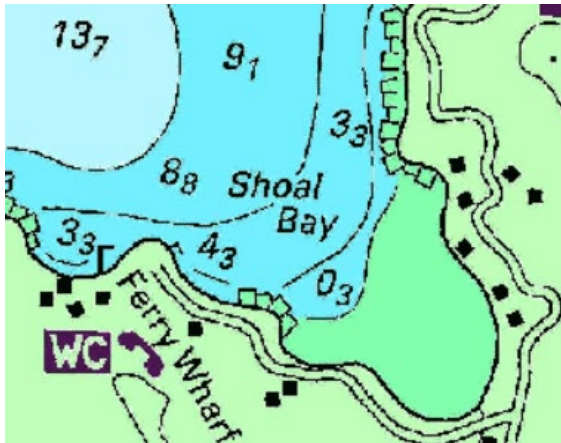
This notice replaces previous Local Notice to Mariners 39 – 21.

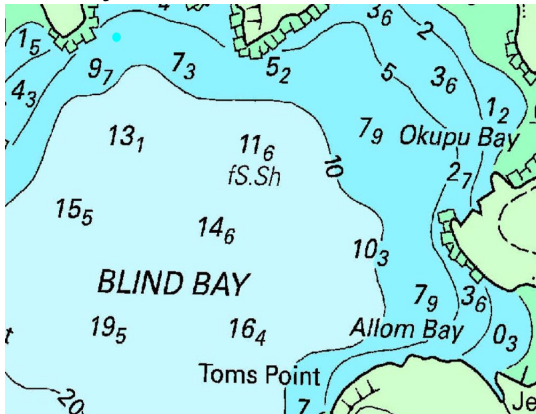
Tryphena Harbour
